

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I pay for my visit?

Third party physicals are not covered under OHIP. Fees for third party physicals must be paid at the time of registration. Payment can be made by credit or debit.

If you have private insurance or an employee benefit plan, you may submit your receipt for reimbursement.

Can I receive prescription renewals for my medications during this appointment?

Depending on the time required to complete your physical, the doctor may agree to provide you with routine health services during your visit. Please make sure that you also have a valid OHIP card with you.

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

Third Party Physicals

What is a Third Party Physical?

A third party physical is a visit with the doctor at the request of another party (the "third party") such as an employer, licensing body, government, school or insurance provider. The purpose of this visit is to complete a form, generate a written report or obtain a Certificate of Good Health that can be given to the requesting party.

What Happens During This Type of Appointment?

During a third party physical examination, the doctor will follow the forms required by the third party. This usually includes your medical history, current medications, past surgical history and lifestyle history.

The doctor will make notes on your general appearance and then check your vital signs: temperature, pulse and blood pressure. Height and weight will be measured, and in some instances, vaccines will be updated.

Our healthcare team may then proceed through a range of possible examinations, such as a hearing test, a pulmonary function test, a visual test and a physical exam, as required.

Who Needs a Third Party Physical?

Examples of individuals who may need require a third party physical include:

- Ministry of Transportation Employees
- Patients with commercial driver's licenses
- Insurance beneficiaries
- Recent immigrants
- RCMP applicants
- Security guards
- Airline employees

Appletree Medical Centres do not provide drug or alcohol testing on site. If required, patients will be provided with a requisition and directed to a local blood laboratory.

How Much Do They Cost?

The fee for this appointment varies, depending on the service provided:

- Ministry of Transportation: \$125
- Physical Exam for Form Completion: \$171

Additional fees may apply if services such as hearing tests and pulmonary function tests are required as well. Please note that third party physicals are not covered under OHIP.

The staff will review your form(s) and perform any basic testing required. The physician will perform a physical exam, and complete your forms.
